- 1. All floats and entries will be judged by the 4th of July theme "A Salute to All Armed Forces".
- 2. All entries must NOT exceed 15 feet in height (from ground to highest point).
- 3. All positioning and placement of the parade entries is entirely reserved by the Harlingen Jaycees. Every attempt will be made to accommodate your request.
- 4. All entries must be at their designated positions by 9:30 a.m. on the day of the parade.
- 5. All late arrivals will be placed at the end of the parade.
- 6. All entries will be officially entered only upon the receipt of the official entry form and a \$10.00 entry fee. SORRY NO REFUNDS.
- 7. In the interest of time and other entries, a maximum 1 minute (60 seconds) stop in front of the Judges stand will be enforced: violations of the time limit will result in disqualification.
- 8. IN THE INTEREST OF EVERYONE'S SAFETY, ABSOLUTELY NOTHING MAY BE THROWN FROM ANY FLOAT AT ANY TIME. Nor may entrants walk along the entry and hand out flyers, candy, etc. This action causes children/adults to move forward and increase a chance of injury.
- 9. Entries must not return through Jackson Street.
- 10. Show cars will be limited to three cars per entry.
- 11. Motorcycle Clubs will be limited to 25 per entry.
- 12. During the parade, please stay within 50 feet of the preceding entry.
- 13. The parade goes "RAIN or SHINE"
- 14. Noncompliance with the above rules may result in removal from the parade.
- 15. Entrants are judged on a 5 point scale for Originality, Adherence to Theme and Appearance.
- 16. No vendors besides the Jaycees will be permitted at the parade.
- 17. The Harlingen Jaycee Parade is an "AT YOUR OWN RISK EVENT". Applications not signed will not be accepted and the entry fee is non-refundable. ENTRY LEADER accepts full responsibility for their entry.
