- 1) Second and final reading to approve an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 10-55 to reflect the following: abandon a 30 ft. road right-of-way on the west side of Travel Lodge Subdivision; a 10 ft. alley located on the south side of Travel Lodge Motel Subdivision; a 10 ft. alley located along the west line of Motel Park Subdivision; an easement for alley and utilities dated January 17, 1973, filed February 5, 1973 and recorded in Volume 952, Page 249 of the Deed Records of Cameron County, Texas; and an easement for alleys and utilities dated January 17, 1973, filed February 5, 1973 and recorded in Volume 952, Page 241 of the Deed Records of Cameron County, Texas, all right-of-ways and easements generally located on the south side of Spur 54 West of Expressway 77. - 2) Consider and take action to approve an agreement between the City of Harlingen and Hogan Lovells US, LLP for federal government relation services. (***Mayor***)

4. Personnel matters involving the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee or to hear a complaint against an officer or employee. Section 551.074 of the Texas Open Meetings Act.
5. The deployment, or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices. Section 551.076 of the Texas Open Meetings Act.
6. Deliberations regarding Economic Development negotiations. Section 551.087 of the Texas Open Meetings Act.
