

investigation shall not exceed seven days in time. Upon the completion of such investigation, if no evidence of fraud, theft, or embezzlement in the selling operations of the registrant, or of the person if any, the registrant represents, is discovered or determined, the Police Department shall issue to such registrant a card bearing: the name of such registrant; the name of the person, if any, the registrant may represent; a statement to the effect that such registrant has been registered and approved by the city for selling within the city; the product or service he is selling; and bearing the signature of the Chief of Police. In the event evidence of fraud, theft, or embezzlement in selling operations of the person registering, or of the business entities he may represent, is developed and discovered in such investigation the registrant shall be denied permission to operate in the city.

§ 115.27 SELLING PROHIBITED WITHOUT REGISTRATION CARD DURING WAITING PERIOD.

Each itinerant vendor or transient vendor, after registering in the manner above provided for in this subchapter, shall refrain from any selling operations in the city until he has received the permit registration card as provided for in § 115.26, (unless such permit registration card is denied as above provided for) provided that such waiting period shall not to exceed seven days. The purpose of such waiting period and the time of such waiting period being determined solely on the basis of the reasonable time necessary to conduct the investigation and inquiry provided for.

§ 115.28 LICENSE FEE.

Each itinerant or transient vendor, at the time of the registration provided for in this chapter, shall pay a license fee over to the City Secretary in the amount of \$50, such fee being based upon the reasonable expense anticipated to be incurred by the city in conducting the investigation provided for in § 115.26. Such fees shall be deposited by the City Secretary in the general fund of the city.

§ 115.29 TERM OF REGISTRATION; EXCEPTION FOR ESTABLISHED RESIDENCY.

The registration provided for in this chapter shall be effective for a one-year period from the date issued. In the event the registrant desires to continue selling activities in the city in the status of an itinerant or transient vendor, he shall again register, pay the license fees, and qualify for a registration card as provided for herein, and do so each year for so long as such registrant shall continue his selling operations within the city in the event the registrant, or the person or other business entities, if any, he may represent, should establish a Cameron, Willacy, or Hidalgo County residence or business situs, in accordance with the provisions of this subchapter the requirement of registering and licensing shall terminate for so long as such established residence or business situs is maintained in Cameron, Willacy or Hidalgo Counties.

§ 115.30 SELLING ON STREETS, SIDEWALKS, OR ALLEYS PROHIBITED.

No person directly or by and through his agents and employees, regardless of nature, itinerant, transient, permanent, locally domiciled, or otherwise, shall engage in any kind of selling activity as described in this subchapter, on the public streets, sidewalks, and alleys of the city.

§ 115.31 PERMIT FOR SELLING ON MUNICIPALLY-OWNED AND OPERATED PREMISES.

No selling activities, described in this subchapter, shall be allowed upon or within any other municipally-owned and operated premises within the city, regardless of the status of such person, including itinerant, transient, permanent, locally domiciled, or otherwise, without such person obtaining a written permit from the city under the terms and conditions and consideration to be determined by the city by other ordinances or by separate negotiation, as the other ordinance of the city may provide, from time to time. Nothing herein shall permit sales on streets, sidewalks, or alleys as prohibited in § 115.30.
