Groundbreaking to Officially Start Harlingen Park Project

Harlingen, Texas—A groundbreaking ceremony will kick-off a project to rehabilitate Vestal Park. Located on the northeast side of Harlingen, the park is about to become the fourth all-inclusive park in the City with play areas designed to accommodate children with special needs. The project includes new playground equipment and a new parking lot. The 14 acre park adjacent to Zavala Elementary already has three soccer fields, a restroom, a small picnic shelter, and a small parking lot with no playground equipment. But that is about to change thanks to a Community Development Block Grant.
