## CITY'S VITAL STATISTICS PROGRAM RECEIVES STATE AWARD SINCE 1999

The City of Harlingen's Vital Statistics Program last month received the Texas Department of State Health Services' Five Star Award for 2015.

The Vital Statistics Unit of the DSHS has given the award to the City's Vital Statistics Program of the Health Department since 1999.

The State's Five Star criteria are as follows:

- Timeliness File death certificates in 10 days or less, and register 95 percent of births within one business day;
- Managing Registration Submit a fully-completed local registrar, self-assessment survey provided by the state's VSU;
- Training Attend the annual vital statistics conference; and
- Remote Search-to-print ration of 60 percent or greater.

"Kudos to the City's Vital Statistics Program for receiving this well-deserved Award," said Ramiro Gonzales, City of Harlingen's Environmental Health Director.

The Vital Statistics Program is an essential function of the City and is a necessary resource.

"City staff continues to provide top-notch services to the community," City Manager Dan Serna said. "State recognition further demonstrates what a great team we have."
