At approximately 11:11am on April 5, 2016, Uniformed Harlingen Police Officers responded to the area of 7th Street & Loop 499 in reference to a hit & run accident that had just occurred. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with the occupants of a Green 2015 Nissan Rogue. Investigation revealed that the Nissan was stopped at the intersection, when it was struck from behind by the driver of a red 2007 Chevrolet Impala. The driver of the Chevrolet fled the scene of the accident, failing to leave information and render aid as required by law. One of the Nissan passengers reported injury and was treated at the scene by EMS personnel.

At approximately 12:45pm (April 5, 2016), a male subject (identified as Daniel Isaiah Munoz Jr.) turned himself into the Harlingen Police Department in connection with the hit & run accident.
