On December 9, 2016 at 8:46 PM, Harlingen Police Officers were dispatched to the 500 block of West Cleveland Avenue, in reference to a suspicious subject. Dispatch advised officers that a male subject was knocking on the door of the caller and another male was lying on the roadway.

Upon arrival Officers observed a male subject who was unconscious lying on the roadway with blood on his face. The male was breathing but not responding. Harlingen EMS was called out to the scene, and the male was transported to a local hospital. During the course of the investigation, Harlingen Officers learned that suspect Jesus Mendoza Perez had assaulted the victim during an argument. During the assault, Jesus Perez caused serious bodily injury to the victim. Harlingen Officers have placed Jesus Mendoza Perez under arrest for the Aggravated Assault causing serious Bodily Injury.
