AUTO-PEDESTRIAN FATALITY

On Sunday, December 11, 2016, at approximately 1:38 AM, Harlingen Police were dispatched to the intersection of New Hampshire Street and Cottonwood Street for an auto-pedestrian accident. When Officers arrived they found 4 people who were struck by a vehicle as they walked north on New Hampshire. One of the victims, a 17 year old male, was pronounced dead at the scene. The other three victims were transported to local hospitals for various injuries. Their ages range from 16-18 years old. The identity of the deceased victim is being withheld at this time out of respect for the family. The driver of the suspect vehicle did not stop and fled the scene in an unknown direction of travel.

Harlingen Investigators are currently looking for an early 90's Chevrolet pick-up truck that will have right side front end damage.
