Aggravated Robbery – Su Casa Inn



At approximately 4:17am on February 10, 2016, Uniformed Harlingen Police Officers responded to the Su Casa Inn & Suites on the 1800 block of W. Tyler Avenue regarding a disturbance. Officers made contact with an adult female subject, who advised that two known male subjects had displayed weapons (a knife and a handgun) and demanded money from her. The two male subjects were located and arrested on the charge of Aggravated Robbery. Members of the Harlingen Police Department's Organized Crime Unit and Criminal Investigations Division executed an evidentiary search warrant at the suspects' room. During the search, Investigators seized illegal drugs, two firearms, ammunition and a large knife.
