## AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

On February 13, 2016 shortly after 8AM, Harlingen Police responded to the 700 block of Pittman Street in reference to a stabbing that had just occurred.

When Officers arrived, they found the victim, a 49 year old male, with a small puncture wound to the middle of his abdomen. The victim identified the suspect as 17 year old Justin Andrew Charles. The victim was transported to Valley Baptist Medical Center and is in stable condition.

On February 13<sup>th</sup> at approximately 10:42pm, Officers of the Harlingen Police Department located wanted subject Justin Andrew Charles on the 300 block of W. Iowa St. in Harlingen. Charles was taken into custody for the outstanding Aggravated Assault warrant, and transported to the Harlingen City Jail. His Bond has been set at \$80,000.
