AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

On February 13, 2016 shortly after 8AM, Harlingen Police responded to the 700 block of Pittman Street in reference to a stabbing that had just occurred.

When Officers arrived, they found the victim, a 49 year old male, with a small puncture wound to the middle of his abdomen. The victim identified the suspect as 17 year old Justin Andrew Charles.

According to the victim, he was drinking with Charles when an argument started. During the argument, Charles stabbed the victim in the stomach. Charles was last seen wearing a gray hoodie with jeans. The victim was transported to Valley Baptist Medical Center and is in stable condition.

The Harlingen Police Department is actively investigating this case and has an active warrant for Charles. Anyone with information on Charles is asked to contact the Harlingen Crime Stoppers at 425-TIPS.
