Impaired Driving Mobilization Step Grant

The Harlingen Police Department, in partnership with the Texas Department of Transportation, focused on conducting D.W.I. saturation patrols in high risk locations during this past holiday season (July 4th). The patrols concentrated during times when alcohol-related crashes were most frequent and ran from Tuesday, June 25, 2019 through Monday, July 8, 2019. During the Enforcement Period, the Harlingen Police Department had five (5) arrests for D.W.I. and three (3) additional arrests. HPD issued citations for 113 violations; 22 for speeding, 2 adult seatbelt violations, 1 child safety seat violation, 13 intersection related violations, 22 no insurance violations, 39 for no driver's license, 3 for distracted driving, and 11 other various violations. HPD also issued warnings for an additional 206 violations; 48 for speeding, 3 for adult seatbelt violations, 63 for intersection related violations, 3 for distracted driving and 89 for various other violations.
