WANTED SUBJECT

On May 4, 2016, Harlingen Police responded to the Hertz Car Rental, located at 3030 Airport Drive in reference to a delayed Theft of Motor Vehicle. According to the Hertz employee, a male subject identified as George Osborne Merrill intentionally failed to return a rental vehicle as agreed on the contract, effectively keeping the vehicle without consent. Merrill had agreed in the contract to return the vehicle by March 28, 2016.

On May 9, 2016 Harlingen Investigators located the vehicle in question, a 2015 Dodge Journey, near the 3000 block of Arroyo Park Lane South. An arrest warrant has been issued for George Osborne Merrill charging him with Theft (a State Jail Felony). UPDATE:

On July 1, 2016 at approximately 6:30 AM, George Osborne Merrill turned himself into the Harlingen Police Department. Merrill was given a PR Bond of \$50,000.00.
