At approximately 8:30am on May 30, 2015, a Uniformed Harlingen Police Officer responded to the 1100 block of North 7th Street in a reference to criminal mischief. Upon arrival, the Officer made contact with a male and a female subject sitting outside the apartment. The female advised that the male subject (Alfredo Hernandez) had caused damage to the apartment, and they had been discussing how the damage was going to be repaired. The argument escalated and turned physical. The female subject (victim) reported that Hernandez pinned her down and applied pressure to her neck with his leg, impeding her breathing. Hernandez was placed under arrest and transported to the City Jail for processing.

The Harlingen Police Department takes all incidents of Family Violence very seriously and investigates fully in order to protect the victim and other affected parties. Anyone who witnesses or is aware of acts of family violence is encouraged to call their local law enforcement agency, family crisis center, or any other agency equipped to assist victims of violence.
