At approximately 11:42pm on June 1, 2015, a Uniformed Harlingen Police Officer stopped a Gray 2014 Chevrolet Cruz on about the 1500 block of N. Ed Carey Drive for defective equipment. Contact was made with the female driver (Demi J. Lopez), who displayed signs of intoxication (unsteady balance, slow speech, appeared disoriented, and had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from her person). After investigation, Lopez was placed under arrest for suspicion of Driving While Intoxicated. It was also determined that female under the age of 15 was a passenger inside the vehicle at the time of the stop, therefore the charge was enhanced to a State Jail Felony.
