At approximately 5:06am on June 4, 2015, Uniformed Harlingen Police Officers responded to the 300 block of Darrell Wayne Shipp Street in reference to a disturbance. Officers arrived on location and made contact with a male subject and a female subject. The adult female (victim) advised that her estranged husband came home and became upset when he found another male subject at the residence. According to the victim, her husband (Adrian Ibarra) grabbed a bat and struck her across the buttocks, causing pain. Ibarra also caused damage to the residence with the bat. Ibarra was placed under arrest and transported to the City Jail for processing. The bat was tagged and secured as Evidence
