## Click it or Ticket

The Harlingen Police Department, in partnership with the Texas Department of Transportation and the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, joined forces with Law Enforcement across the State to save lives on Texas roads and highways by working together to increase seat belt use. The “Click it or Ticket” campaign was created to increase awareness of the importance of buckling up each and every time someone gets into a vehicle. Wearing a seat belt increases the chances of surviving a serious crash by 45% (NHTSA). The Harlingen Police Department Click it or Ticket campaign ran from May 18, 2015 through May 31, 2015. During the Click it or Ticket campaign enforcement period, H.P.D. issued 146 citations (tickets) and 6 warnings.
