On June 7, 2015, an adult female Harlingen resident (victim) filed an assault report at the Harlingen Police Department. The victim reported that at approximately 2:00am, she had been sleeping at her residence (25000 block of Coconut Drive) when she was awakened by her husband. The victim advised that her husband (Agapito Vasquez Trevino) had placed his hands around her neck and threatened to kill her. The victim managed to break away and attempt to leave. As she attempted to leave, Trevino pushed her to floor, causing pain and discomfort. Officers responded to the victim's residence and located Trevino. He was placed under arrest and transported to the City Jail for processing.
