Burglary at City Auditorium

At approximately 8:45am on Wednesday, June 10, 2015, a Uniformed Harlingen Police Officer responded to the City Auditorium / Casa De Amistad located at 1204 Fair Park Blvd. in reference to a Burglary. Contact was made with the reporting party, who advised that the break-in had occurred between 4:00pm on June 9, 2015 and 8:43am on June 10, 2015. The initial investigation revealed that unknown subject(s) had used a rock to break a glass door located at the back of the building. The unknown subject(s) then entered the building without consent or authorization. Once inside the subject(s) discharged two fire extinguishers causing approximately \$150.00 in damages to the carpet and used an unknown object to cause approximately \$400.00 in damages to a vending machine. The subjects then removed (stole) two Dell Laptops computers, a computer mouse, a credit card swiper, and twelve LED UV Flashlights for a combined total value of \$2,375.00. The cost to repair the back door was estimated at \$500.00. Detectives and Crime Scene Technicians responded to process the scene.

Through the course of the Investigation, Detectives and Officers have interviewed several parties, and have developed leads and suspects in this case. At this point three juvenile subjects have been arrested and some property has been recovered. The Investigation into the Burglary continues. Updates will be posted as things develop.
