At approximately 11:41pm on June 9, 2015, a Uniformed Harlingen Police Officer stopped a White 2000 Dodge Van for disregarding a stop sign on the 600 block of W. Pierce Avenue. The Officer made contact with the female driver, who could not produce a valid driver's license or insurance. During the interview, the driver (**Patricia Mares Bravo**) displayed signs of intoxication (red blood-shot watery eyes, slurred speech, and had an odor of alcohol emitting from her person). The Officer also located a 12 ounce bottle of Bud Light Beer inside the vehicle. Bravo was unable to perform the standardized field sobriety tests, and was subsequently placed under arrest for suspicion of **Driving While Intoxicated**. A records check revealed that Bravo had several outstanding Harlingen Municipal Court warrants. Bravo was transported to the City jail for processing.
