At approximately 4:00pm on June 10, 2015, a Uniformed Harlingen Police Officer stopped a Maroon 2014 Nissan Sentra for disregarding the stop sign at Sonesta Drive & E. Austin Street. The Officer made contact with the female driver, identified as Alicia Salazar Torres. During the contact, the Officer detected a very strong odor of marijuana emitting from within the vehicle. After being informed of her legal rights, Torres advised the Officer that she had marijuana on the floor board. The Officer then located and seized 10.1 grams of marijuana. Torres was placed under arrest and transported to the City Jail for processing. The marijuana was tagged and secured as Evidence.

The Harlingen Police Department's core values begin with our respect for life. We revere the truth and strive to affectively enforce the law with the assistance of our community. The Harlingen Police Department investigates all reports or incidents of illegal drug / narcotics activity. H.P.D. encourages community members to notify the local law enforcement agencies of any incidents of suspected illegal drug activity.
