At approximately 8:08pm on June 10, 2015, a Uniformed Harlingen Police Officer stopped a Blue 2004 Nissan Maxima near 25<sup>th</sup> Street & E. Adams Street for an expired inspection sticker. Contact was made with the occupants of the vehicle. During the contact, the Officer detected an odor of marijuana emitting from within the vehicle. During the investigation, the male driver, identified as Reymundo Martinez, was found in possession of 6.5 grams of marijuana. Martinez was placed under arrest and transported to the City Jail for processing. The marijuana was tagged and secured as Evidence.
