At approximately 5:00pm on June 8, 2015, a Uniformed Harlingen Police Officer responded to Forever 21 (2020 W. Expressway 83) in reference to a theft. Contact was made with the Loss Prevention Officer. The Loss Prevention Officer advised that between April 11, 2015 and May 28, 2015 an employee had been stealing from the business without consent or authorization. Investigation revealed that the employee had used fraudulent refunds for store credit and made purchases totaling \$484.24. Through the course of the Investigation, the Detective identified the employee (Cassandra Torres) and an arrest warrant was obtained. Torres turned herself into the Harlingen Police Department on June 11, 2015.
