On May 21, 2015, a Uniformed Harlingen Police Officer made contact with an adult female Harlingen resident on the 1400 block of North First Street regarding a burglary to her residence. The victim reported that between 8:00pm on May 20, 2015 and 11:00am on May 21, 2015, unknown subject(s) had gained entry into her residence through a bedroom window. Once inside, the unknown subject(s) removed (stole) several items (47" flat screen television, table lamps, and a laptop computer for a combined value of approximately \$1,700.00).

During the Investigation, the Detective located and recovered the victim's laptop at a local pawn shop. The item had been pawned by a male subject identified as Angel Galvan. An arrest warrant for Angel Galvan was then obtained for the Offense of Theft. Galvan turned himself into the Harlingen Police Department on June 11, 2015.
