On June 11, 2015 at approximately 5:22 PM, Harlingen officers were dispatched to the 7100 blk. of W Business 83 in reference to a hit and run crash which had just occurred. Upon arrival contact was made with the victim who stated that an unknown male driving a gray passenger car did a U-turn and crashed into the side of his gray Pontiac Grand AM and fled the scene without leaving any information pertaining to the accident. An adult female passenger was complaining of pain to the neck and back at which time EMS was called out to the scene. The suspect vehicle identified as a 2000 Ford Taurus, was later located along with the adult male driver identified, as Esdras Carrizales. After further investigation it was also determined that Mr. Carrizales had hid the vehicle in the back yard to an abandoned residence. Mr. Carrizales was charged with Accident Involving Injury and Tamper with Evidence.
