On June 14, 2015, a Uniformed Harlingen Police responded to a residence on the 2000 block of E. Madison Avenue in reference to a report of Sexual Assault. The Officer made contact with the victim (an adult female Harlingen resident). The victim reported that a known adult male subject had contact of a sexual nature with her and without her consent. The male subject (identified as Jose Raul Paiz) was located and placed under arrest for Sexual Assault.
