On 6/15/15 at approximately 6:58 p.m., Harlingen officers were dispatched to a theft that had just occurred at the JC Penny store located at 2006 W. Exp. 83. Upon arrival, contact was made with the reporting person who stated that a known actor identified as Maikel Guzman knowingly and intentionally took property from inside the store without making an attempt to pay for the property. The reporting person stated that Mr. Guzman then exited the store and fled the scene, depriving the store of property. The total amount of property taken is \$130.00. The property was described as a Swiss Army bag, and a pair of wire cutters. Harlingen officers located Maikel Guzman, and placed him under arrest for the theft. He was then transported to the city jail for booking.
