At approximately 6:07am on June 18, 2015, a Uniformed Harlingen Police Officer responded to the 4200 block of Wilson Road in reference to an Assault. The Officer made contact with the victim (an adult female Harlingen resident). The victim advised that her common-law husband (Jessie Alvarado Martinez) had pushed her to the ground, causing pain and bodily injury. Martinez was located and placed under arrest for Assault / Family Violence, and transported to the City Jail for processing.

The Harlingen Police Department takes all incidents of Family Violence very seriously and investigates fully in order to protect the victim and other affected parties. Anyone who witnesses or is aware of acts of family violence is encouraged to call their local law enforcement agency, family crisis center, or any other agency equipped to assist victims of violence.
