At approximately 1:45am on June 21, 2015, a Uniformed Harlingen Police Officer stopped a Red 2005 Pontiac Grand-Am for a traffic violation (improper turn) at the intersection of Hale & Ed Carey. Contact was made with the driver, identified as Remigio Cantu. During the contact, Cantu displayed signs of intoxication (red blood-shot watery eyes, slurred speech, and had the distinct odor of alcohol emitting from his breath). Cantu refused to perform the standardized field sobriety tests, and was placed under arrest for suspicion of Driving While Intoxicated. Cantu refused to provide a breath sample and was transported to the hospital for a blood draw pending a search warrant reviewed and signed by a Judge, as per HPD's "No Refusal" policy.
