On May 9, 2015, a Uniformed Harlingen Police Officer made contact with an adult female (victim) on the 1500 block of E. Harrison Avenue in reference to a theft. The victim reported that at around 8:00pm she was at a residence on the 900 block of Orange Heights to sell some items (cell phones). While making contact at the residence, a young male subject grabbed the phones (two Samsung Galaxy S6 edge cell phones valued at \$1,560.00) and fled the area. Through the course of the investigation, the Detective identified and linked a male subject to the theft. An arrest warrant was then obtained for the male subject (identified as Justin Andrew Charles). Charles was located and arrested on June 22, 2015.
