On June 1, 2015 at approximately 4:20 A.M. a uniformed Harlingen Police Officer observed a gray Pontiac Grand Am with defective equipment and conducted a traffic stop on the 200 block of S. 13th Street Harlingen, TX. Contact was made with the driver, Cheyenne Taylor Rivera, and during the course of the investigation it was found she lied about her identifying information due to seven outstanding warrants from the city of Harlingen totaling \$1,866.80. During the inventory of Rivera's property, Officers discovered two yellow oval pills (generic Xanax - Alprazolam) inside of her purse. Rivera was additionally charged with possession of controlled substance.

The Harlingen Police Department's core values begin with our respect for life. We revere the truth and strive to affectively enforce the law with the assistance of our community. The Harlingen Police Department investigates all reports or incidents of illegal drug / narcotics activity. H.P.D. encourages community members to notify the local law enforcement agencies of any incidents of suspected illegal drug activity.
