On May 10, 2015 at approximately 8:47 A. M. Harlingen Police responded to the 600 block of Maco Drive in reference to a burglary to a business.

According to the reporting person, the incident occurred on May 10, 2015 between 3:00 A. M. - 5:00 A.M. The suspects gained entry from the roof and crawled to the office through the attic and made entry into the office by breaking the sheet rock. Once entry was made the subject(s) took \$3,600.00 in US Currency from the safe.

Video surveillance provided from the business assisted Officer in the identification of one of the suspects, Kelly Jason Malone. Investigators obtained an arrest warrant for Malone and members of the Gulf Coast Violent Task Force located him on June 1<sup>st</sup>, near the 800 block of South K. Street. Malone was taken into custody without incident. Investigators are working to identify the second suspect in the video.
