Auto-Bicyclist Hit and Run Arrest

On 3/2/2019, at approximately 8:40AM, the Harlingen Police Department responded to an Auto-Pedestrian Crash at Northbound Frontage and Wilson Rd. A blue in color Mazda passenger car had struck a bicyclist on the Frontage Rd., and then fled the scene of the crash. Information was received by a witness that assisted the Officers in locating the suspect vehicle, and driver. The 37 yr. old male suspect was taken into custody for the Hit and Run, and is currently awaiting arraignment in the Harlingen City Jail.

The 47 yr. old male victim was treated for minor injuries.
