NARCOTICS SEARCH WARRANT / TWO ARRESTED



On March 7, 2016, members of the Harlingen Police Department's Organized Crime Unit were conducting surveillance at a residence on the 500 block of Lozano Street, in Harlingen, Texas regarding suspected illegal narcotics activity. Investigators observed a suspicious Silver Chevrolet Silverado pick-up leaving the residence and requested assistance from a marked Law Enforcement unit. With assistance from the Cameron County Sheriff's Office, the pick-up was stopped at the intersection of FM 511 and Old Alice Rd by a CCSO Deputy. Contact was made with the driver (Alfonso Salazar) who provided consent to search the pick-up. During the search, Officers located and recovered 2.55 pounds of cocaine. Salazar was arrested on the charge of Possession of C/S and transported to the City Jail.

Investigators then obtained a search warrant for the residence on Lozano Street. During the execution of the Search Warrant, Investigators located and seized US currency, two handguns, and items associated with illegal drug sales. An adult male, identified as David Anthony Williams, was arrested and charged with Manufacture / Delivery of C/S.
