On May 1, 2016 at 3:16 AM, Harlingen Police responded to the 1200 block of North 77 Sunshine Strip, (Stripes), in reference to an Aggravated Robbery call. Officers made contact with the store clerk who stated that an Anglo male, with shoulder length hair walked into the store, and handed him a black backpack demanded money, verbally and in writing. The store clerk advised officers that he observed a large knife in the suspect's waistband. The store clerk advised that he tossed the backpack back at him and fled the store. When the store clerk was safely outside of the store, he contacted the Harlingen Police Department. The suspect then fled the area on foot and walked into an alleyway of a nearby neighborhood. During the investigation, officers learned that Joshua Humphries had committed the Aggravated Robbery. Officers located Humphries at his residence, where he was placed under arrest and transported to the city jail.
