Weather Advisory



The weather report for today indicates windy with scattered thunderstorms during the morning hours, becoming more widespread this afternoon. High 88F with winds ENE at 20 to 30 mph. The chance of rain 80%. Locally heavy rainfall is possible. Harlingen Police Department would like to advise everyone as they head out today please use caution. If you do not need to be on the roadway, please avoid driving during inclement weather.

The following are a few tips for driving during inclement weather:

1. Focus on the road
2. Slow down
3. Avoid tailgating
4. Keep calm
5. Avoid driving through flooded areas (puddles / standing water)
6. Obey all traffic control devices (including emergency barricades)
7. Pull over and / or stop when necessary
